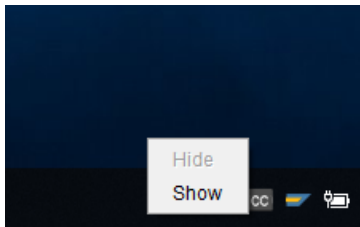

# 1 Setting up the HTML5-based print job agent

## 1.1 Changeover to the HTML5-based print job agent in parallel operation

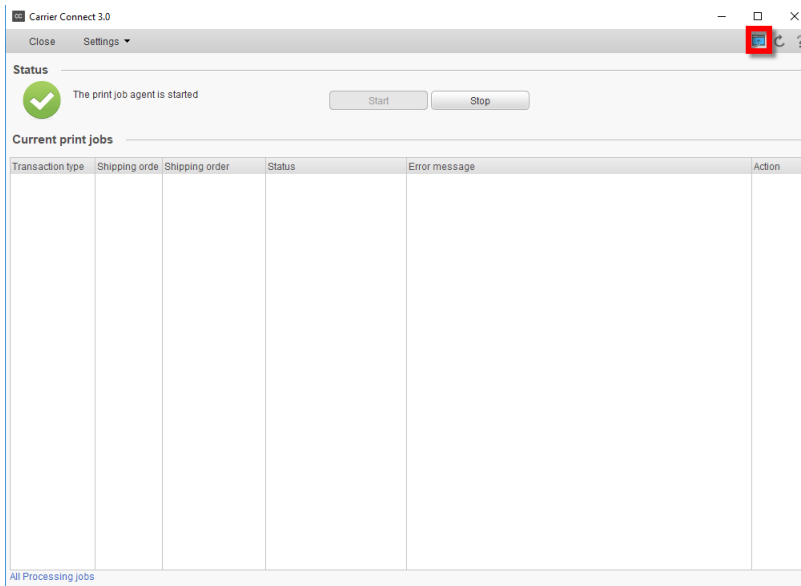
Proceed as follows:

1. Open the AEB cockpit in your SAP® system.
2. Select the product *Carrier Connect*.
3. Click on *Print job agent* in the *Applications* sheet.  
The print job agent opens and runs in the background.



4. Have the print job agent displayed. To do this, right-click on the CC icon in the menu bar and select *Show*.

5. To start the once-only test of the HTML5-based web interface in parallel operation, select the blue icon in the now visible print job agent as shown in the screenshot.



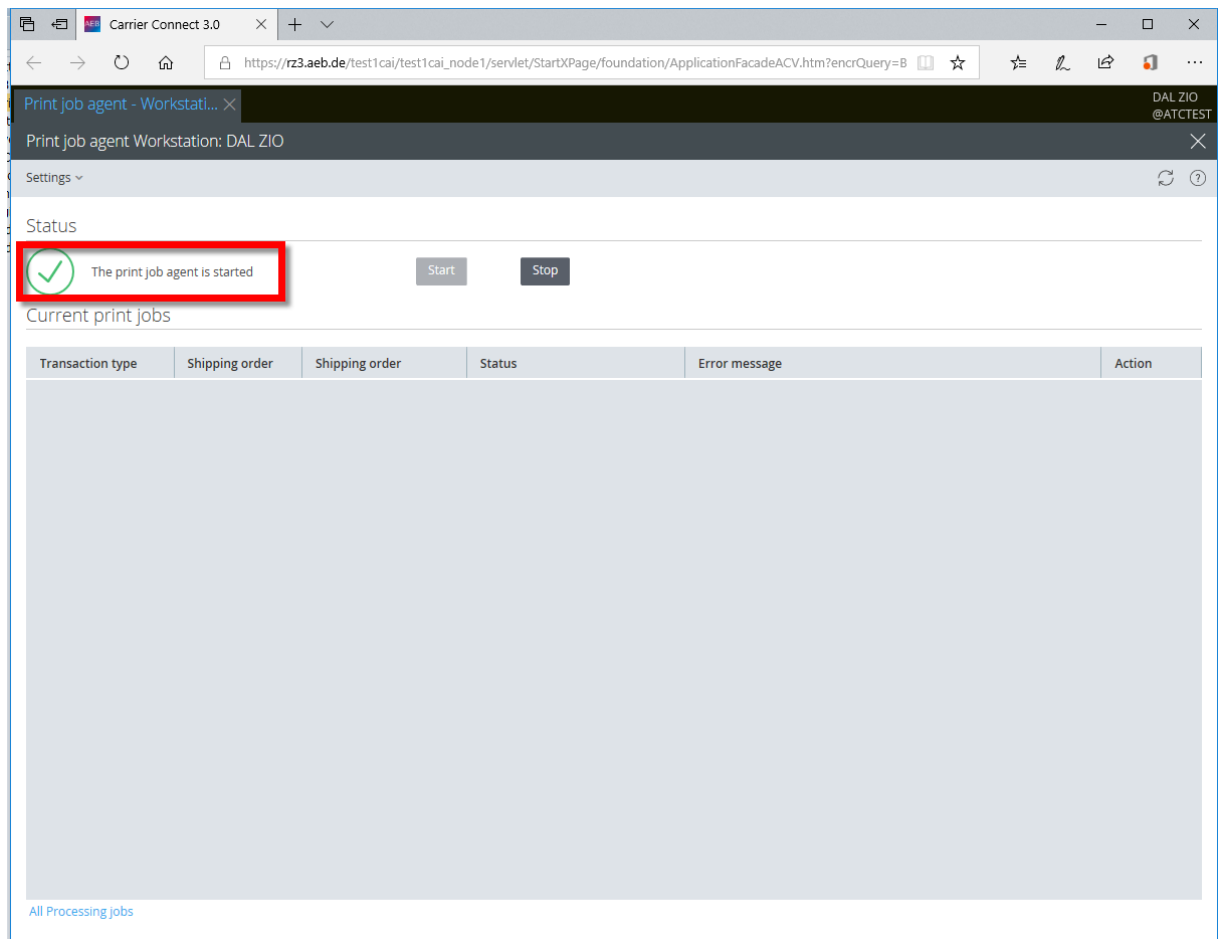
6. A prompt is displayed in which you need to verify whether the option *Try HTML5 web application once* has been enabled. Confirm the prompt by clicking *OK* to start parallel operation.
7. Close the print job agent by clicking *Close* in the upper right area of the window.
8. Re-start the print agent as described above.  
The print job agent opens in your browser as a HTML5-based application. Install the AEB Service Agent now to enable printing.

- » The AEB Service Agent can be used both with and without local administrator rights of the user. When you first use the new HTML5-based interface for printing, you will be prompted to install the Service Agent once or permanently. AEB recommends installing the AEB Service Agent permanently.

### 1.2 Installing the AEB Service Agent permanently for setting up printing

#### Proceed as follows:

- » Administrator rights are required to install the AEB Service Agent permanently.
1. Open the print job agent as described in section 1.1.
  2. Select *Download installer* from the prompt that opens.
  - 💡 If the installer does not open, change temporarily to another browser.
  3. Execute the downloaded installer.
  4. Confirm the browser prompt whether you want to change the app by clicking Yes. (This prompt is browser-dependent and may vary).
  5. You will be informed that the print job agent has been started.



6. Now the print job agent is fully operational and you can print your labels under the HTML5-based application also after the end of parallel operation.
- » In contrast to the Java-based print job agent which is in the background in the taskbar, the HTML5-based print job agent opens in the browser and must be minimized manually.
