# 1 Introduction

In the following, you will find information on how to change the URL for uploading the EDI file "PLD0200" by the transport service provider UPS.

- » This guide applies to ASSIST4 applications that use ACMS and AEB Connectivity Services to upload data to UPS.

## 2 Changing the URL address

### 2.1 Preparation of the change

#### 2.1.1 Prerequisites for changing the URL address

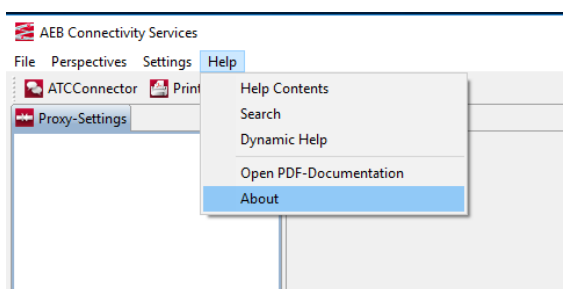
To change the URL address, the following conditions must be met:

- AEB Connectivity Services is installed on your system in version 1.3 or higher. See the section below to learn where to find the current version. If the version condition is not met, you need to perform an update. Information about this can be found at [service@aub.com](mailto:service@aub.com).
- The URL [www.ha.ups.com:443](http://www.ha.ups.com:443) must be enabled on your firewall/proxy.
  - » The URL must only be enabled on the server on which AEB Connectivity Services is installed.

#### 2.1.2 Checking the version of the AEB Connectivity Service

Proceed as follows:

1. Call AEB Connectivity Services.
2. Go to the *Help menu* and click *About*.



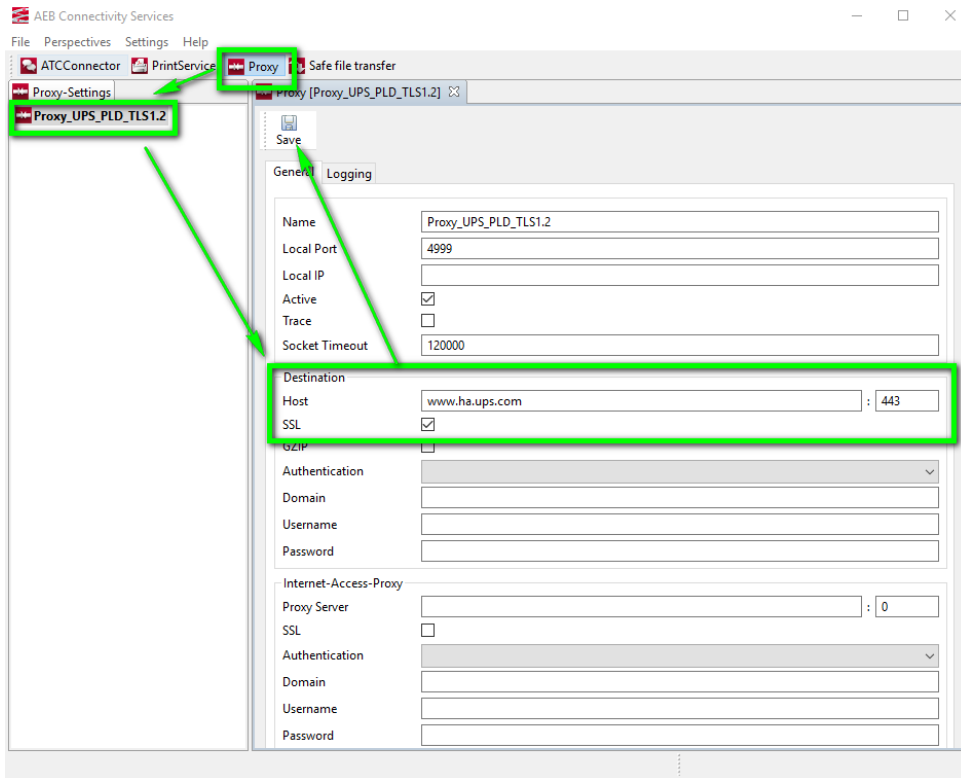
3. Check your version number.



## 2.2 Changing the URL address in AEB Connectivity Services

Proceed as follows:

1. Call AEB Connectivity Services.
2. Click *Proxy*.
3. Select the UPS entry.
4. Enter the new URL in the *Host* field: [www.ha.ups.com](http://www.ha.ups.com)



5. Save your changes.

- » No further changes need to be made. AEB recommends that you restart the service of the AEB Connectivity Service once.
- » Your UPS contact can explicitly tell you whether your UPS EDI file "PLD0200" has arrived at UPS.
